In September 2007, the Council for Legal and Judicial Reform (CLJR) through its Permanent Coordinating Body (PCB) as a daily coordinator and Project Management Unit (PMU) as an operator, accountably performed its works according to the identified missions and achieved a number of following results:

1. Activities related to Legal and Judicial Reform

a) Administrative tasks

- Sending letters to relevant ministries requesting the nomination of one representative to be a member of the Technical Working Group of Indicator and Monitoring System for Legal and Judicial Reform project,
- Sending invitations for the meeting of the technical working group for Legal and Judicial Reform on 17 October 2007,
- Sending invitation for the meeting to discussion the criteria and standard of model court on 5-7 November 2007 in the Project management unit of the Council for Legal and Judicial Reform
- Sending requests for comments on the draft of Cambodian country assistance evaluation report of the independent evaluation group, IEG of the World Bank.

- Meeting with the Evaluation Working Group of CCJAPIII to review the CCJAPIII project implementation on 26 October 2007,
 - Meeting with UNDP working Group to report the progress of the implementation of Access to Justice project on 5 October 2007.

 - Participate in the inter-ministerial meeting on the draft law on telecommunication.
